Farewell greeting of IAS President Antonio Dentoni Litta

At the end of my period as President of the Conference of the members of the IAS, let me briefly review what has been achieved in those recent industrious and successful years that and take stock of what has been achieved.

Everything originates from the agreement signed in 2005 between the then Department for goods and archival library of the Ministry for Cultural Heritage and Activities, the Centre for Research and Interdisciplinary and Multidisciplinary Studies at the University of Maribor, the International Institute of Archival Science in Maribor and the State Archives of Trieste. That agreement brings, among others, even my signature, as representative of the Department delegated by professor Salvatore Italia, and the definition of the Convention which led to Trieste, at the State Archives, the International Institute of Archival Science of Trieste and Maribor was also the result of my personal belief, as well as Italian Archival Administration, that this international collaboration could produce a new useful tool for comparison and professional growth, and I'm confident to say that this happened!

The continued gradual increase in international membership, the interest aroused by the issues discussed, from the creation of the multilingual dictionary and the initiatives put in place, especially in the field of training, and also in terms of institutional formalization of partnerships established with Russia, Romania and Israel, the presence here of representatives of the highest international body in the archival field, the ICA, the support of prestigious institutions such as the CEI and the International Institute for Theoretical Physics (ICTP), which hosts the Autumn Archival School for many years, are among the signs of what we can certainly call a success! I would particularly recall the topics covered in the annual conferences over the years from 2005 to 2010: - University, Archives and Archival Education - Archival Ethics - Audiovisual Archives – Digital Archives - Private Archives - Valorisation, Managing and Security - Archives in the Twentieth Century: Technical and Professional Aspects – Archival Legislation - Web sites dedicated to the Archives. I think that a special mention deserves the training, for which I claim authorship of the idea. It was, in fact, from my proposal immediately welcomed with enthusiasm by the members of the Conference, the Director of the IAS, dr. Peter Pavel Klasinc, as well as by dr. Grazia Tatò, director of the State of Trieste, which also assumed the responsibility to coordinate their activities, that the Autumn archival School begun and got a growing success reaching the fifth year of its life. I personally strongly believe in education as an engine of reflection, collaboration, exchange of experiences and dissemination of science. The satisfaction that the initiative has met internationally confirms what we imagined.

To the original group of young officials from most of the Central and Eastern Europe, colleagues from distant countries such as Malaysia, the Sultanate of Oman and Israel have joined. The School has been designed for a three-year cycle and, therefore, have now come and gone several participants; the significant applications for membership, beyond the actual possibilities for organizational formulas also lead to think wider and try to find resources in other subjects to be complementary to those given by the Italian Ministry.
